On this sheet you will find a series of tasks and activities relating to each area of the curriculum. You can complete these activities when you want and how you want over the time that you are off school.

You have to do the activities in bold. All other activities are suggestions to keep you busy. Remember to read every day.

Each activity or task is related to your year group, is designed to be open ended, and can all be done at home with minimal resources.

ENGLISH

- Read a minimum of 3 fiction book and/or non-fiction books.
- Practise the Year 2 common exception spelling words
- Practise phase 6 phonics using Espresso which can be accessed through the school website within the Learning Zone tab.
- Write a book review for each of the books that you have read.
- Practise your handwriting/ letter formation.
- To complete the past SATs practise paper for reading. This includes 2 papers.
- To complete the past SATs practise paper for spelling, punctuation and grammar.
