Phonics	<p>What's in the Box? See Mrs Thomas' demonstration video on Class Dojo.</p> <p>Continue to use objects with s, a, t and p at the beginning but add in some different objects to what you used last week.</p>	<p>'S' Sound Hunt Practise making the 's' sound. Remember, it is a stretchy sound. Now go on a hunt and collect different objects that start with the 's' sound (snake, scissors, sock etc...). Upload a photo with all the objects you managed to find in the Class Portfolio area on the Class Dojo website.</p>	<p>Musical Letters On pieces of A4 paper write different letters of the alphabet (write in lowercase, not capitals) and play some music. When you stop the music ask your child to stand on a letter and then repeat for the other letters. For most children 4 or 6 letters will be enough and you can add more over the coming weeks.</p>	<p>Cake Bake Rhyming Game https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/member-only/CakeBake.html</p> <p>Username: march20 password: home</p>	<p>Blending Game Look at this YouTube clip to see what blending is: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=qWn-gxUddqo Select 5 objects and put them all on the floor together. Then sound out a word such as c-a-t and see if your child can blend the sounds to make cat and select the correct object. Your child may need you to blend with them the first few times. Remember, they do not need to see the letters at this stage.</p>
Literacy/Numeracy	<p>Watch Mrs Thomas' Story Time on Class Dojo</p> <p>Have a chat about the story and practice name writing</p>	<p>Have a pretend picnic together. During play ask your child for amounts of objects e.g. 'Can you give Teddy 5 grapes?', 'I would like 2 apples please' etc...</p>	<p>Watch Mrs Mephams' or Miss Mushuta's Story Time on Class Dojo</p> <p>Create a Rainbow Look at the Portfolio area of Class Dojo and upload a photo of your rainbow.</p>	<p>Musical Numbers - Write digits 1-10 on separate pieces of paper. Place them on the floor in random order. Play music. When you stop the music, say a number and your child must go and stand on that number. Challenge - ask your child to order the digits.</p>	<p>Handwriting - watch Mrs Thomas' handwriting video on Class Dojo and complete at home.</p>
