Phonics	<p>What's in the Box? Continue to use mainly objects with s, a, t and p at the beginning but now also add a couple of other objects.</p>	<p>Animal Bingo Match the sound with the animal https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/AnimalBingo.html</p>	<p>Blending Game Select 5 objects and put them all on the floor together. Then sound out a word such as c-a-t and see if your child can blend the sounds to make cat and select the correct object. Your child may need you to blend with them the first few times. Stop and discuss which words rhyme.</p>
Literacy/Numeracy	<p>Watch Mrs Thomas' Story Time on Class Dojo</p> <p>Have a chat about the story and practise name writing</p>	<p>3D Shapes https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=quNdJ5MtX1A Watch the YouTube clip and practise saying the shape names. Afterwards, go on a hunt and find 3D shapes in your home. Upload a photo of what you found on Class Dojo.</p>	<p>Watch Mrs Mepham's or Miss Mushuta's Story Time on Class Dojo</p>	<p>3D Shapes Have a selection of 3D shapes on the floor. Ask your child if they remember any of the names? Recap names and cover with a piece of fabric. Hide one of the objects and ask your child to identify which shape is missing and repeat.</p>	<p>Handwriting - watch Mrs Thomas' handwriting video on Class Dojo and complete at home. Upload a photo of your handwriting on Class Dojo. Use whatever tools you have (pencil and paper, paint, whiteboard, crayons...).</p>
