Phonics	<p>What's in the Box? This week add in objects with the initial sounds i, n, m and d.</p> <p>This clip may be helpful for parents who need support pronouncing the sounds: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TTe5_EmOBHQ</p>	<p>Musical Letters Sing - https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=75p-N9YKqNo</p> <p>On pieces of A4 paper write different letters of the alphabet (write in lowercase, not capitals) and play some music. When you stop the music ask your child to stand on a letter and then repeat for the other letters. For most children 4 or 6 letters will be enough and you can add more over the coming weeks.</p>	<p>I Spy... Play I Spy... using initial sounds. Watch this clip and then play I Spy... using objects in your home. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=n4YaF-jXWuY</p>	<p>Blending Game Select 5 objects and put them all on the floor together. Then sound out a word such as c-a-t and see if your child can blend the sounds to make cat and select the correct object.
