



How to take part in a Live Lesson?

Here's everything you need to know:

1 What is Google Meets?

Live Lessons are a great way to get some time with your teacher and take your remote learning to the next step. Your teachers are going to use a Live Video tool called **Google Meets**.



If you're using a Phone or Tablet you will need to pre-install the Google Meets app from Play or the App Store

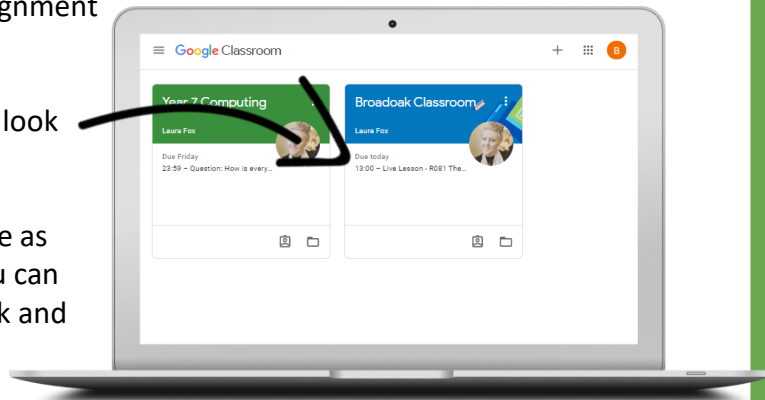


2 How do I know I've been invited to a Live Lesson on Google Meet?

Your teacher will send you a Live Lesson Assignment in your Google classroom.

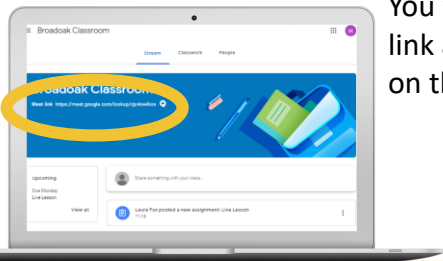
On your Google classroom home page it will look something like this.

The Live lesson will show you a time and date as well as being labelled as a **Live Lesson** so you can tell the difference between your weekly work and Live Lesson assignments.

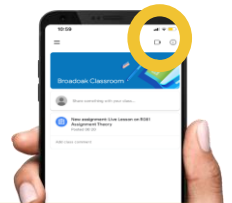


3 I've got a Live Lesson Assignment – now what?

You will need to access the meeting by clicking on the Google Meet link at the top of your subject classroom. This link is inside the banner on the Stream Tab.



If you're using a mobile or tablet, you will also be given a small camera option to click on at the top



Rules:

- You can not access the classroom without your teacher present. Google will not allow you to do this. If it says "Can't find Meeting" or "Meeting not available" this means your teacher has not yet logged on.
- You should be on time and in a suitable location for the lesson. Somewhere quiet where you can concentrate.
- Your teacher will go through the classroom expectations at the start of each lesson.
