**ST JOSEPH:** The Pope has named this year the year of St Joseph. Like Mary, the mother of Jesus, St Joseph has many different names and Feast days. **Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> May marks the Feast of St Joseph The Worker.** Our Praise Assembly this morning began with a celebration of St Joseph The Worker. We asked St Joseph to inspire us to work hard at school and with everything we do.



**HOLY COMMUNION:** Today we had a service for year 4 where they were presented with their Holy Communion certificates from last year. Well done to everyone.

**ADDITIONAL SUPPORT WITH LEARNING:**

Letters went out this week to some children who we have identified need additional support. To ensure that children gain the maximum benefit they must be at school ready to come through the door at 8am if they have been given a morning slot. To limit disruption to the class **any child who is late will not be permitted** and parents/carers will need to wait with them until the gate opens at 8.35am.

Children will be supervised by the adult leading the class between 8.30am and 8.35am when the school day begins. Siblings are welcome to attend breakfast club to make it more convenient for parents/carers. There is a charge of £2.50 per child.

**LUNCH MENU:** We apologise for the changes to the lunch menu but we are just trying to make sure that the food that is served to the children is what they like to eat. Hopefully the most recent change will be the last change to the menu until September.

Today the kitchen informed the school that, due to the bank holiday and delivery schedules they will not be able to serve chicken thighs next Tuesday. This meal will be served on Thursday and chicken sausages will be served on Tuesday instead.

**AFTER SCHOOL PROVISION:** After school provision was suspended during lockdown. We know how important this provision is to some families. However numbers have been very small and the after school club has been running at a deficit of approximately £500 a month. This has been subsidised by the school but is not sustainable.

A few weeks ago we asked parents to express an interest in using the after school facility but very few families have expressed an interest so the situation has not changed.

We would like to be able to re-start the after school provision after half term.

We will then be able to calculate whether the provision can be self-funding, which is our aim. We do not intend to make money but the provision does need to be self-funding.
