Dear Parents/Carers,

Following government guidance and having updated our risk assessments we will be going ahead with live performances of our Christmas productions. To ensure everyone's safety we have put in place the following measures.

- Limit the number of adults gathering in one place and ensuring they are socially distanced.
- Ensuring that the Hall is well ventilated
- Asking ALL adults to wear a face covering
- Asking ALL adults to remain in their seats

The chairs in the hall will be set up in pairs. On the day of your child's play you will be asked to take a seat and remain seated. No standing is allowed. Please do not move the seats. You will also be required to wear a face covering. We would also encourage you to take a Lateral Flow Test before attending any of the performances.

Unfortunately you will not be able to move around the hall to take photographs. This is to ensure everyone's safety. We will take some group photos and put them on the website. We ask you to enjoy the moment, not through a lens, but by being truly present.

At the end of the play the children will be invited to give you all a wave and will then leave the stage. You will be asked to leave the hall a line at a time to avoid overcrowding in the corridor. Please support us to keep everyone safe by following these measures.

The Nursery play will now be shown on two consecutive days to avoid overcrowding. A maximum of two tickets will be allocated for the Carol Service. To avoid overcrowding these will be either for the afternoon or evening session, not both. However your child will need to attend both performances to enhance everyone's experience.
