

Nursery – Learning From Home

On this sheet you will find a series of tasks and activities relating to each area of the curriculum. You can complete these activities when you want and how you want over the time that you are off school.

You have to do the activities in bold. All other activities are suggestions to keep you busy. Remember to read every day.

Each activity or task is related to your year group, is designed to be open ended, and can all be done at home with minimal resources.

Literacy

- **Read a selection of fiction books.**
- **Read a selection of non-fiction books.**
- **Draw a picture of what has happened in some of the books you have read.**
- **Practise writing your name in lowercase.**
- Practise letter formation, particularly correct formation of the letter 'a' if it is in your name ('round the apple and down the leaf').
- Singing rhymes (Old MacDonald, The Wheels on the Bus, Humpty Dumpty etc..)

Numeracy

- **Practise counting to 10 or 20.**
- **Practise counting out up to 10 or 20 objects.**
- **Practise recognising numerals to 10.**
- **Order numerals to 10.**
- Sing counting rhymes such as '10 in the Bed'.
- Say what is 1 more or 1 less of a given number.
- Is there anything in your house that you could measure? Or weigh?

RE

- **Practise making the Sign of the Cross.**
- Discuss how you can grow more like Jesus during Lent (sharing your toys, saying sorry if we do something wrong etc..)
- Read The Easter Story. Discuss that the Cross is special because it helps us to remember God's great love for everyone. Can you design and make a cross?

PSED

- Play turn-taking games such as Snap.
- Discuss feelings. What makes you happy? What makes you sad? How can you tell how someone else is feeling?

Communication & Language

- Following instructions from an adult to help make a meal.
- Play 'I Spy...'

Understanding the World

- We have been learning about growing. Do you have any plants at home? Help your adult care for plants by watering them.
- Next half term we will be learning about Minibeasts – what is a minibeast? Can you find out?
- Can you go on a minibeast hunt?

Physical Development

- Practise standing on one foot.
- Complete a Cosmic Yoga session (can be found on YouTube).
- Practise throwing and catching skills.
- Can you think of some movements to add to your favourite song?

Expressive Arts and Design

- Junk Modelling – what can you make using the recycling in your home?
- Make playdough with your adult (see recipe attached). You can use the playdough to do 'Dough Disco' available on YouTube or make models.
- Create artwork based on stories you have read. Explore using different materials such as felt tips, colouring pencils, crayons etc...
