THANK YOU all for your support and
patience while we dealt with the
aftermath of a flood in the basement.
The basement area, which is
approximately 7ft deep, was completely
submerged in water, shutting off our
water and toilet facilities. We had a
building company on site by 7.30am on
Tuesday morning, pumping out the
water. They have worked around the
clock to get the school up and running
again and cold water and toilet facilities
were resumed early Thursday morning.

The damage is being assessed to have a
full picture of the extent of the works
needed to be completed.

The school has been able to re-open this
morning. Parents of children in years 3 to
6 have been asked to send their children
in with a packed lunch to support the
kitchen staff. This will be for today only.
