**THANK YOU:** To everyone for supporting the school to improve what we do. This includes getting the children to school on time and collecting them on time. There has been a massive increase in punctuality with almost all children arriving on time. This sets them up well for the school day. We have also seen a decrease in late collections. The staff and children are delighted that there time is no longer being wasted by waiting in the school office at the end of the day.

**BEHAVIOUR:** We had a very positive staff meeting this week around managing behaviour in the school. The most common challenging behaviour was children's disrespect towards staff by ignoring or refusing to follow instructions. This behaviour was mostly directed towards support staff. Children have been reminded that all staff are here to help them and keep them safe and how it is important to listen to them and follow instructions. Please reinforce this at home with your children. We are in the process of re-writing the behaviour policy. Once this is done we will be sharing the policy with a group of children for their feedback. We will then be inviting parents to give their feedback on the policy.
