They desperately need warm water proof clothes to support them through the winter.

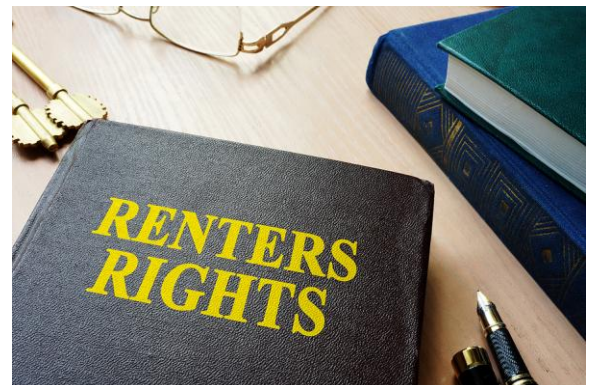
The school will be accepting donations (for men and women) of the following items between **Monday 6th and Friday 10th October**.

WORLD ATHLETICS SUCCESS

Many of you have followed the progress of the British middle distance runner Georgia Hunter Bell, whose mother Mrs Bell is our PE & Sport Lead.

We want to congratulate Georgia on her silver medal win in the 800m in the recent World Athletics Championships held in Tokyo. This is her 3rd medal on a world stage following on from her Olympic Bronze medal in 1500m in Paris and her World Indoors Bronze 1500m in Nanjing. Georgia is the National British Women's record holder for 1500m in 3.52.61, and is second with her 800m time of 1.54.90.

We look forward to meeting her in school later this year. Georgia joined the local ESM club who are based at Perivale Track, and have training on Tuesdays and Thursday evenings from 6.20pm -7.30pm. More information is available on the ESM website.
