BEING KIND: Last week I accompanied a small group of children to a work shop on 'Truth to Power'. The children learned that they have a voice and they must use this voice to make a difference. We are already doing this with our Sustainability Projects. We were the first school in Ealing to submit a Climate Action Plan and we have made the biggest impact in the past year to reduce our Carbon Footprint.

The children generated some great ideas to improve our school including monitoring the equipment to make sure that it was ready to be used. This includes our Chrome Books and the playground equipment. They have made a great start by counting how much equipment is put out in the playground and counting how much is left at the end of each week to assess our losses. They will be sharing their findings at Monday morning assemblies.

They also agreed that we would participate in **WORLD KINDNESS DAY** in November and February. We will be sharing more about this next week.

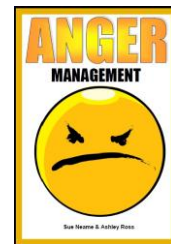


SPY DOG, SPY CAT, AND SPY PUPS SERIES: We have been made aware of a concern about the books in this series.
