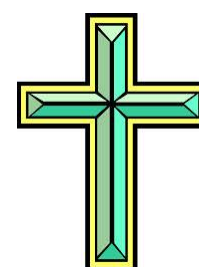


Summer Term

- In Summer 2 we will learn about some friends of Jesus and listen to a visitor talk about their faith.

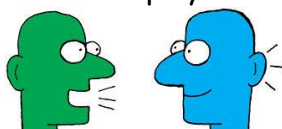


Personal, Social and Emotional

In PSED we continue to learn the importance of rules and we will develop our confidence in talking in front of the class. We will also be encouraged to attempt to resolve any disagreements by ourselves. We have moved over to RSE and we are now engaging in behaviour that God would be proud of, listening to Bible stories to learn how to achieve this.

Communication and Language

Our role-play area will provide opportunities to learn and apply new language and vocabulary. We will also continue to listen to stories in our listening area and we will try to recall the stories.



Physical Development

In PD we will be explore travelling in different ways such as over, under, around and through to help develop balance and coordination.

We will work on refining our pencil control, as well as our ability to use other tools effectively, such as scissors.



Literacy

We will begin to read more complex words and sentences using both sight vocabulary and phonics. Rhyming words will be consolidated. Independent writing will be a focal point from now on to prepare us for Year 1. We will need to make sure that we are practising to read and write our tricky words at home.

Mathematics

In Mathematics we will explore numbers to 20 and beyond. We will embed our ability to share and group and continue to consolidate our understanding of odd and even and doubles. We will continue to work with 2D and 3D shapes and we will also create our own patterns and verbalise the rule.

We will start the Summer Term by exploring growing and planting. We will then learn about the seaside and create our own pirate maps. As we near the end of the term, we will start to prepare for Year 1.
