YEAR 4 BENIN WORKSHOP

Year 4 had a fantastic time taking part in a Benin Kingdom workshop on Wednesday. Throughout the day, the children developed their understanding of this fascinating civilisation by placing key events and dates in chronological order, helping them to build a clear timeline of the Kingdom of Benin. They also explored the different roles within Benin society, learning about the responsibilities and importance of various groups, from the Oba (king) to skilled craftsmen and traders.

The workshop was full of engaging activities and amazing facts that enhanced our learning and deepened our understanding of the Kingdom of Benin. The children showed great curiosity, asked thoughtful questions and thoroughly enjoyed discovering more about this remarkable African kingdom.

Did you know? At its height, Benin City was surrounded by a huge network of earth walls and moats stretching for thousands of kilometres. Some historians believe they were among the largest man-made earthworks in the world, even longer than the Great Wall of China when all the sections are added together!
