Online - Safety: During the welcome meetings for new parents this month, we talked about the impact of allowing young children too much access to devices like tablets and smart phones. Research has shown that this is 'hot wiring' their brains in a different way. We have noticed the following behaviours:

1. Poor attention span and lack of concentration
2. Speech, communication and language delay
3. Increase in aggressive behaviours
4. Poor sleep patterns
5. Prolonged tantrums when the device is taken away

Please limit your child's access to these. 10 minutes at a time a couple of times a day for children under 5 is more than enough.
