INSTRUMENT LESSONS FOR THE AUTUMN TERM 2019

FOR PARENTS OF CHILDREN IN CURRENT YEARS 2 TO 5 ONLY

Dear Parents,

If you would like your child to start having or continue to have instrument tuition lessons (for children in current years 2 to 5), can I please ask that you complete the form below and return it to the school with your tuition monies by **Friday 12th July 2019.**

The tutor will continue to provide 10 weekly half hour lessons during the term at a cost of £4.50 per lesson **£45.00** per term. However, the school is able to provide a reduction in the cost of music lessons for children whose parents have registered for Free School Meals or have ever received Free School meals. If your child's name is on the free school meals list that we receive from Ealing, then the cost of music tuition is reduced to £30.00.

The lessons take place during the school day and all lessons are taught in very small groups of mostly 4/5 – this ensures the children benefit from plenty of one-to-one tutoring. **The choice of instrument is: Guitar or Keyboard.**

With the exception of the keyboard, it will continue to be parents` responsibility to ensure that their child has the correct instrument both to bring to school for their lesson and to use at home for practice purposes. A number of shops hire out musical instruments or you can of course buy your own – a guitar for example can be purchased at a very reasonable cost from the retail outlet Argos (please note that a child who is left handed needs a left-handed guitar).

If you would like your child to reap the many benefits from learning to play a musical instrument, please make payment by logging onto School Money and select either Guitar or Keyboard and make the payment **Friday 12th July 2019.**
