are delighted to announce that we have secured a Gold Games Mark for our P.E and Sport for the second consecutive year.

Every child in Years 4, 5, and 6 has taken part in at least one inter-school event during this school year. As well as the comprehensive competition programme run by Willow Tree School Sports Partnership, we have competed in additional sports events run by Brentford FC, Trailfinders Rugby, St Benedict's School, the Brownlee Triathlon Foundation and Arsenal FC.

We have won medals in Cross-Country running, Tag-Rugby, Tri-Golf, Panathlon, Football, New Age Kurling and came 4<sup>th</sup> place in the Borough for Sportshall Athletics. The boys' football team won the Peal Plate, 2 pupils in Y6 were selected by Ealing Borough to run in the London School Games and our school competed in the London Panathlon finals at the Copperbox in Stratford, and in Tri-Golf at the Mini Youth Games at Crystal Palace this week.
