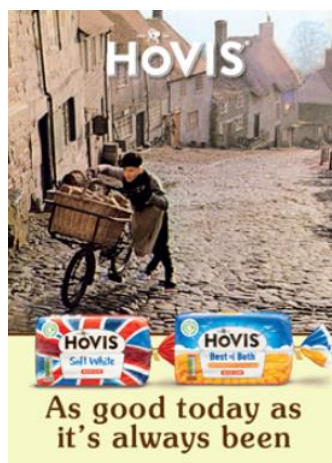


We are now also taking part in the newly launched Peal Shield Hi5 Netball league and we went on to a match against Fielding.
