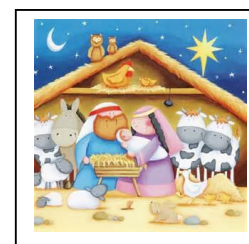

Mad Science and Thames Water came to help raise awareness and educate us about FATBERGS!!

We qualified for this as our school is in an area where the sewer network is not performing as well as in other areas and where planned sewer cleaning is operated throughout the year. The assembly raised awareness on the detrimental effects on our sewers when wet wipes, nappies, and other non-flushable products are flushed down toilets and oily fats being poured down sinks. It also taught us, how we can help prevent the blockage of underground sewers and help promote a safer and cleaner way of disposing items.
