Dear Parent/ Carer,

The school has received several emails from parents regarding the school trip on Monday and a Whats App group that is sharing concerns. Whilst we understand that parents may be concerned it is important to let us know so we can take these into consideration.

We are monitoring and following Public Health England (PHE) advice daily, while continuing to operate our school day as normal, keeping an informed, calm perspective. We have assessed the risk to the trip and concluded that it is mild due to the fact that we will be travelling by coach and the majority of the time will be spent outside.

We received the following communication from The Tower of London.

*“Currently we are open and are welcoming all school groups to our sites. We are managing our learning spaces in line with the latest advice from Public Health England for educational settings. We have made cleaning sprays available for school staff and adult helpers to use in all lunchroom areas across our sites, in addition to our daily cleaning schedule. All groups taking part in object handling sessions are being asked to wash their hands before and after sessions, with hand washing proactively encouraged at school meeting points. Staff and volunteers across our palaces have been fully briefed on government guidance, and will be able to advise on the location of toilet facilities most easily accessible for your group.”*

Therefore the trip will be going ahead as planned. However if you wish to withdraw your child from the trip you have every right to do so. The school will provide your child with alternative provision within school but please be aware that this is likely to be in another year group.
